B. Must Be

A CONSTANT DWELLING

Definition: *dwell*—to settle down in, to be at home

AN ABUNDANT DWELLING

Four Ways the Bible Will Dwell in Us

1. Hear It

"Who hath ears to hear, let him hear." (Matthew 13:9)

2. Handle It

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)

3. Hide It

"Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee." (Psalm 119:11)

4. Hold It Fast

"Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain." (Philippians 2:16)

TO INSTILL DOCTRINE INTO THE CHRISTIAN

"Holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers." (Titus 1:9)
