GOD WAS MANIFEST IN THE FLESH

Definition: Gentiles—people or nations, used in contrast to the Jews

"I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise. 15 So, as much as in me is, I am ready to preach the gospel to you that are at Rome also. 16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek." (Romans 1:14–16)

BELIEVED ON IN THE WORLD

"Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved." (Acts 2:47)

RECEIVED UP INTO GLORY

Definition: received up—to take us, raise up

"And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel; 11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven." (Acts 1:10-11)
