1. Stay—Learn to Stick

"Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching." (Hebrews 10:25)

Reasons People Leave

- A Spiritual Reason—the Will of God
- Get Offended
- Undisciplined—It Takes Character to Stay Somewhere
- Backslidden

2. Sweet Spirit—Love Your Church

"And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:" (Hebrews 10:24)

3. Stewardship—Give Liberally to God and Man

"But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully." (2 Corinthians 9:6)

4. Separation—Direction, Standards

"Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you," (2 Corinthians 6:17)

5. Stick with Scriptures
