1. THE _____ OF HIS BLOOD

Quote: “It cost more to redeem us than to create us. In creation there was but ‘speaking the word.’ In redeeming us, there was ‘shedding the blood.”—**Thomas Watson**

A. _____ **Our Life**

“In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;” (Ephesians 1:7)

Definition: *redemption*—a releasing effected by payment of ransom liberation procured by the payment of a ransom

“Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.” (1 Peter 1:18-19)

Definition: *redeemed*—to release on receipt of ransom; to liberate by payment of ransom

B. _____ **Our Life**

NEW START

“And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.” (Hebrews 9:22)

Definition: *purged*—to cleanse, of filth impurity, to prune trees and vines from useless shoots, cleansed so it can produce fruit

NEW OWNERSHIP

“For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God’s.” (1 Corinthians 6:20)

“Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.” (Acts 20:28)

A. **God’s Righteousness Is** _____

“For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;” (Romans 3:23)

Definition: *propitiation*—a means of appeasing or expiating, a satisfactory payment to satisfy

Quote: “Propitiation addresses the wrath of God.”

“Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.” (Romans 5:18)

A. Peace _____

“And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven.” (Colossians 1:20)

B. Peace _____

“For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16)

“Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.” (Romans 5:9)

“The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.” (2 Peter 3:9)

C. Peace for All Who _____

“He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself; he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son. 11 And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.” (1 John 5:10-11)
