1. An Unbelievable Command Genesis 22:2 Abraham must offer his son, Isaac.

2. A Faith-filled Response Genesis 22:5 Abraham obeyed immediately.

Abraham told men he and Isaac will return. Abraham told Isaac God will provide "himself" a lamb.

Abraham raised the knife to slay his son.

3. Jehovahjireh Genesis 22.14

Jehovahjireh = Jehovah + Jireh
