Wife's #2 Fuel = Intimate (Deep) Conversation Song of Solomon 8:7a Many waters cannot quench love, neither can the floods drown it: . . .

1. Preparing for Intimate Conversation . . . Time! Time – plan time because it takes time Like affection, it should be daily.

Goal? 15 hours a week . . . 2 hours daily

2. Profit of Intimate Conversation . . . meeting her needs!

Ephesians 5:25a Husbands, love your wives, . . . Colossians 3:19a Husbands, love your wives, . . .

A. Her #1 Fuel = affection/love.

Expressing affection/love is usually with conversation.

These require intimate conversation. Marriage is teamwork. Teamwork requires communication, agreement.

- A. Converse to inform, investigate, understand
- B. Develop interest in each other's favorite topics
- C. Balance (the conversation). Don't interrupt.

- 5. Summary Advice for Intimate Conversation Care always, comfort often, cure sometimes . . .
- A. Remember your dating days talking, sharing
- B. She needs to share with someone who cares . . . show you care
- C. Encourage her to share . . . personal feelings, past experiences, present activities, and plans for the future.
- D. Be home . . . overnight . . . everyday
- E. 2 hours daily, 15 hours weekly together.
