2. THE _____ FOR SIN

A. Jesus _____

Definition: "*justification*"—to be declared in right relation to God through Jesus Christ

"Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. 11And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God." (1 Corinthians 6:9–10)

B. Jesus Justifies _____

Definition: "*propitiation*"—turn away anger by offering a gift, to cover or gain favor

B. We are Saved from _____

"Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him." (Romans 5:9)

C. We Have _____

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God." (1 John 5:13)
