Hope: Living Fearlessly in a Scary World

Hope = 1. wish/want, 2. Trust, 3. wish/want + expect

Hope 6: Fear of Death (Hebrews 9:27)

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:

- 1. It is common to fear death.
- 2. Death is part of every life. Romans 5:12; Romans 6:23; Hebrews 9:27
- 3. The Bible explains death, = separation.
- A Physical death = separation of body from soul/spirit. Genesis 35:18
- B. Spiritual death = separation of human spirit from God (eg Adam and Eve after sin).
- C. 2nd death = separation from God for eternity. Revelation 20
- 4. Jesus Christ conquered death for us.
- A. Jesus defeated the Prince of Death (Hebrews 2:14-15).
- B. Jesus defeated the power of death (Hebrews 2:14-15; 1 Cor 15:56).
- C. Jesus gives us reason to face the future (death) with faith and hope, not fear.

The Day of Christ

- 2 Thessalonians 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;
- 1. Paul beseeches Christians . . . (2 Thessalonians 2:1-3)
- A. Because Christ's coming and our gathering together
- B. Be not shaken, troubled, deceived
- 2. Paul teaches Christians . . . (2 Thessalonians 2:3)
- A. Apostasy first
- B. Anti-Christ next

Anti-Christ's behavior

- ⁴ Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.
- C. Proud opposes God, exalts himself
- D. Deceiver sits in God's temple for worship, shews himself to be God
- 3. Paul reminds Christians.
- ⁵ Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?
- A. Paul visited them.
- B. Paul told them then and now.
