Notes: 1. Introduction

- a. Last 12 months pandemic uncertainty
- b. But God does not change.
- c. Context: Moses is now dead
 - Joshua is now new leader
- d. Watershed moment - point of change
 - nation of Israel coming into Promised Land
 - many statements frequently repeated
 - about 600,000 males numbered
 - time of spring / snow melt off

2. Clear Vision

- a. Priority - see Ark of the Covenant
 - symbolized God's presence,
 - Mercy seat on top of Ark
 - See holiness of God
- b. Day of Atonement
 - once a year only
 - blood of sacrifice on Mercy Seat to atone for people's sins
- c. Jn 16:13 God leads thru Spirit & Word

3. Complete Trust

- a. God provides guidance
 - Israel had not gone this way before
 - life of faith is journey into the unknown
 - Trust God into unfamiliar territory

4. Clear Heart

- a. Sanctify yourself
 - take sin out of your life
 - Prepare yourself for God's service
- b. Purity today for God's blessings tomorrow
- c. Mental purity, emotional purity, practical purity
- d. Joshua asked the people to come & hear Lord's words
- e. Approach God in holy reverence

5. Committed Action (vs. 14-17)

- a. Nation to move their tents
- b. Faith is not passive
 - leaders went thru camp
 - People to go after the Ark
- c. Nation crossed across dry land
 - priests dipped their feet in water
 - spring run-off water heaped up way upstream at village Adam next to Zarethan
