Notes: 1. Introduction

- a. Christian is child of God - John 1:12
- b. God adopts the sinner
- c. Christian in God's family
- d. Christian can pray to Heavenly Father
- e. Christians (God's children) represent God's family

2. God chastens His children (Point 5)

- a. Chasten: word implies discipline &/or correction
- b. God loves us enough
 - God takes time & trouble to correct His erring children
- c. Do not despise God's correction
 - Do not quit or refuse God
 - Heb 12:5-11 (quote from Prov 3:11-12)
 - human fathers corrected us
 - chastening makes Christian partakes in God's holiness

3. God's Chastening Proves His love (Point 6)

- a. God receives you (Christians = God's love)
- b. Heavenly Father corrects His child

4. Chastening Proves Christian is God's child (Point 7)

- a. Natural for human father to correct ~~for~~ his child
- b. Someone else's father will not correct children who do not belong in his family

- a. Christian response
 - Willing to accept God's chastening?

- d. Christian does ~~not~~ ^{NOT} happy when corrected - painful lessons
- e. But mature reflection brings joy later in life
