- a. Eccles 8:17 Know it all? always something more to discover & know
 - no one on earth knows everything
 - even Satan does not know all things
- b. God however knows all things
 - see Job chap 38-41

- a. government authority
 - Eccles 8:2a, 4
- b. natural laws of physical world
- c. Family unit - husband & wife
 - Gen 1:27-28, 2:23-24; 1 Cor 11:8-9, 11

- b. God knows the future

- a. Eccles 8:8 - people live, people die - humans have no control ^{life or death}
- b. 2 Pet 3:16 Paul wrote things hard to understand (even Peter)

e. Only God can shorten or prolong days in person's life

- Prov 10:27 Fear of the Lord prolongs life but years of wicked's life shortened
- Ps 90:12 Teach us to number our days

- God's view = Rom 3:23 for all have sinned
