Joseph the Dreamer Lesson 4 "Defeating Temptation"

1 Corinthians 10:13 There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

Temptations = tempt, test, trouble

1. Temptation is Deceitful.

- A. Lie #1 "it's ok to just look." (39.7)
- B. Lie #2 "it's not that bad." (39.9)
- C. Lie #3 "it's only 1 time." (39.10)
- D. Lie #4 "No one will ever know." (39.11)
- E. Lie #5 "I don't have a choice." (39.12)

2. Temptation can be defeated.

A. Joseph decided beforehand.

"I will not . . ."

B. Immediate refusal. (39.8,10,12)

"No" immediately, not delayed.

C. Joseph honored God. (39.9)

Best reason to say no to sin is to honor God.

Overcoming Discrimination

Exodus 2:1-2 And there went a man of the house of Levi, and took to wife a daughter of Levi.

²And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when she saw him that he was a goodly child, she hid him three months.

House of Levi = tribe of Levi, 12 sons of Jacob

Took to wife = married

Daughter of Levi = girl from tribe of Levi

Conceived = pregnant

Bare a son = gave birth to a son

Goodly child = good, handsome [parents think that]

A. In His Identity

" . . . refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter" (Hebrews 11:24)

B. In His Failure

He acted in the flesh and killed a man.

He (pride) delayed the work of God.

C. In His Solitude

He learned humility, patience.

D. In His Surrender

Moses' excuses at the burning bush

Moses' surrender at the burning bush

E. In His Triumph

Moses led Israel out thru Red Sea
