- Christian victory - our Christian faith

- Without faith, impossible to please God - Heb 11:6

- Heb 11:1 faith substance of things hoped & evidence of unseen things

- 1 Kings 19:1-2

b. Elijah runs for his life - 1 Kings 19:3-4

- He then hides in the wilderness

- He despairs of status of his life

- modern example - Martin Luther

- modern preacher - Charles Spurgeon

- many psalms speak of overwhelming circumstances
