1. Introduction

- a. Context of apostasy
- b. Not "fight" as in anger or violence
- c. Written 60-65 AD
- d. Ancient writings given in beginning
 - Jude brother of James
 - bondservant of Jesus Christ
 - Mt 13:56, Mk 6:3½ brother of Jesus
 - * now we don't know Him after the flesh anymore - 2 Cor 5:16
 - * Acts 1:14 Jesus family converted as adults
- e. Written to Christians (called, sanctified & preserved)
 - Jude gives blessing (mercy, peace, love)

2. Faith Delivered to the Saints (vs. 3)

- a. Jude originally desired to write about Christian common salvation
- b. Priority = Christian faith
- c. Faith delivered once for all in Jesus
 - Jesus is the cornerstone of faith - Eph 2:20
- d. Danger = ungodly men in church
 - apostasy = denying Lord Jesus Christ
 - turning God's grace into sexual sin
 - Satan father of lies - John 8:44

3. Faith Denied (vs. 4-9)

- a. Ungodly men come into church secretly
 - creep inside quietly
 - they are unnoticed inside in beginning
- b. Example 1: Israel (vs. 5)
 - God saves Israel from Egypt
 - God destroyed unbelieving people in wilderness
- c. Example 2: rebellion of angels (vs. 6)
 - angels left their first estate ~~in heaven~~
reserved for them
 - rebellious angels have eternal darkness
- d. Example 3: Sodom & Gomorrah (vs. 7)
 - cities engaging in perverted sexual practices
 - suffering eternal fire
- e. False teachers (false prophets) - vs. 8
 - defile the flesh
 - reject authority
 - speak evil of dignitaries

3f. Even archangel could (vs.9)
not speak against Satan
- but instead invoked God to rebuke him

4-Evil Doers (vs.10-~~14~~-16)

a. Cain = way of Cain
- am I my brother's keeper?

- Your brother's blood cries out

b. Balaam: error of Balaam

- sold God's gift for money

- greedy for human profit

- rebellion of Korah

c. Korah: rebellion to Aaron & Moses (Gen 6:14-24)

- first cousin to Aaron (Gen 16:1-11, 31-32)

- tried to replace Aaron (vs.12-13)

d. Evil doers comparisons (in a drought)

- clouds with no rain

- dead fruit trees

- deadly ocean storm waves

e. Evil doers common actions (vs.16)

- grumbling & complaining

- walking in their sinful lusts

- mouth speaking flattery - using people

5. Faith Defended (vs.17-)

a. Remember: apostles gave warnings

b. Recognize ungodly people (vs.18-19)

- mockers

- ungodly lusts

- hedonism (love of pleasure)

- causing divisions & fights

c. Christian actions for themselves (vs 20-21)

- build up Christian faith

- praying in Holy Spirit

- keeping yourself in God's love

- continue looking for God's mercy

d. Christian actions for others (vs.22-23)

- have compassion on some

- others save with fear pulling out of

the fire - see also Acts 20:28

* with fear? protect yourself from

fire

* protect yourself from other dangers

(vs.24-25)
