1. Introduction

- a. Scorn comes to Christians at some time or another
- b. Live unashamed of the Savior
- c. Scorn either gives you incentive to live for God or
- d. Four incentives from scorn

2. Reckons an Comparison (compare)

- a. Demon discerned Paul & his group
 - it knew who Paul was - Acts 16:17
 - it knew whom Paul served - God
- b. Servant's heart
 - Jesus took on form of servant
 - Philp 2:7-8
- c. Soul winning habit
 - it knew Paul's purpose
 - * proclaiming way to salvation
 - * Acts 16:17

3. Buries Concern

- a. Paul & Silas ministry
 - thrown into prison - Acts 16:23-24
 - beaten & persecuted
- b. Popularity not the goal
 - ministry to preach gospel of Christ
 - Paul not ashamed gospel of Christ
- c. Persecution guaranteed
 - 2 Tim 3:12 all who live godly
 - world hates Jesus of Nazareth
 - dead people don't retaliate Gal 2:20

4. Builds Confidence

- a. Denial of Pride
 - No boasting - James 4:6
 - At midnight Paul & Silas praying & singing - Acts 16:25
 - * need more strength when our strength gone - 2 Cor 12:9
 - * Christian sufficiency of God
 - * Christians are mere branches Jn 15:5
- b. Duty of praise
 - praise that God knows Christian Problems
 - Content in whatever situation occurs - Philp 4:11
 - Give thanks & praise to God
 - * Heb 13:15, 1 Pet 1:7, 4:11

5. Became a channel

a. Heavenward response - Act 16:25

- prisoners heard them singing
- Christian basis of respect from others
- * opens door of ministry to others
- * Christians had different response different from others

- Jesus on cross

* "Father forgive them"

* Luke 23:34 - Act 16:26-27

b. Human response - Act 16:26-27

- large earthquake destroyed prison
 - jailer thought prisoners escaped
- c. Historic result
- but all prisoners still in prison, even with open door - Acts 16:28
 - jailer was going to kill himself
 - jailer, "What must I do to be saved?" - Acts 16:30
