1. Introduction

- a. Every day of life is gift of God
- b. Christianity is simple
- c. One verse - John 3:16 simple
 - some use academia to leave Bible
 - Is 47 wisdom & knowledge perversion
- d. Four areas of simplicity

2. Simplicity of the Gospel

- a. Question of kingdom of Israel
 - Jesus answer - Only God knows (1:6)
- b. Focus on facts of the gospel
 - 1 Cor 15:3-7 death, burial, & resurrection of Jesus
 - Mt 12:40 son of man 3 days & nights in earth
- c. Function of the gospel
 - accepting gospel because Jesus saves
 - God gives salvation for human soul
- d. Finality of the gospel
 - Gal 1:6, 8 another gospel? NO
 - gospel truth of Jesus death, burial & resurrection

3. Simplicity of Governance

- a. Christians gathered in an upper room
 - ecclesia - called out group - Acts 1:13
 - beginning days of church
 - 11 apostles leaders
- b. Place of prayer
 - prayer brings down God's power
 - prayer only requires presence & faithfulness - Acts 1:14
 - Christians pray & God works
- c. Pursuit of purity
 - group wanted to replace Judas Iscariot - vs. 1:16-20
 - Peter gives requirement for apostle
 - * were with Jesus from His baptism until His resurrection - vs. 21-22
- d. Power in preaching - Acts 2
 - apostles speaking in power of Holy Spirit - Acts 2:4, 6, 8 Act 2:14
 - great sermon on Day of Pentecost
 - foolishness of preaching - Act 1:18, 21

4. Simplicity of Growth

- a. Acts record of witnessing & Christian converts - Acts 2:41
- b. Growing a church (not a crowd)
- c. Intolerance toward unfaithfulness
- 3000 people converted & baptized
- converts continued steadfastly (faithfully) in doctrine, fellowship, Communion, & prayers
- d. Ingredient of unity
- 1:14 with one accord
- 2:1 one accord in one place
- 2:46 with one accord
- e. Infusion of unction
- 2:4 all filled with Holy Spirit
- 2:44 together
~~- 2:47 with one accord having favor~~
~~- 2:47 with one accord having favor~~
- 2:16-21 pour out God's Spirit

- a. Praising God in song - Judges 5:3
- b. To thank God every morning - 1 Chron 23:30
- c. Praise God's glorious name - 1 Chron 29:13
- d. Praise God in rejoicing - Ps 9:2
