## a. Rom chap 6

- Christian dead to sin
- Christian walk in newness of life
- Christian counts themself alive  
to God
- Christian slave to God for holiness

## b. Luke 7:36-50 Simon the Pharisee

- interaction between Simon & Jesus
- 2<sup>nd</sup> interplay between Jesus &  
sinful woman washing his feet
- 3<sup>rd</sup> interplay of Jesus' parable
- woman was not ashamed of Jesus
- Simon ashamed to give Jesus full  
welcome into his home
- question: Who loved Jesus more?

## c. Jesus calls Christian to deep

commitment of loving living  
Wanted to show love (vs. 37-38)

## 2. Sinful Woman

## a. Chance to show her love to Jesus

- alabaster jar of fragrant oil  
\* very expensive body oil
- she came prepared with herself  
& her jar

b. Jesus eating meal with Simon in his  
home

- most meals taken in reclining position
- she stood behind Jesus at Jesus' feet
- she cried washing Jesus' feet with  
her tears
- she dried his feet with her hair
- she kissed his feet & anointed his  
feet with oil
- Jesus was not ashamed of her  
spectacle scene - but accepted her

## 3. Sinful Woman Poured Out Her Love

a. Woman gave Jesus the proper  
welcome to Jesus' meal

## b. Woman approached Jesus humbly

c. Woman provided for Jesus where  
Simon the host was lacking

## d. Woman stepped into the gap

#### 4. Other criticized sinner Woman (vs 39,49)

- a. Simon thought inside himself
  - if Jesus were a prophet
    - \* if... if... if
    - \* that she was a sinner
  - woman with a bad reputation
- b. Jesus had something to say to Simon
- c. Outwardly Simon called Jesus "Teacher"
- d. teacher word of respect - teacher who forgives sins?  
Who is this that also forgives sins? (vs. 40-43)

#### 5. Jesus tells Simon a parable

- a. Creditor with 2 debtors
  - one debtor owed small amount of money
  - 2nd debtor had large debt
- b. Creditor writes off both debts
  - owe no more money
- c. Jesus "got you" question
  - who will love creditor the most
- d. Simon rightly answers, "the one with the largest debt owing"

#### 6. Jesus Praised sinful Woman (vs. 44-46)

- a. Jesus compares Simon to woman
- b. She washed my feet
  - Simon gave no water to wash feet
- c. She gave multiple kisses to Jesus feet
  - Simon gave no kiss of welcome
- d. She anointed Jesus feet with oil
  - Simon did not anoint Jesus head with oil

#### 7. Conclusion (verses 48-53) 47-50)

- a. sinful woman loved much & her many sins (large debt) are forgiven
- b. Side note to Simon - little forgiveness loves little
- c. Jesus sends away the woman with her faith going in peace.
