

1. Introduction

- a. Chap 10 twelve disciples sent out preaching & doing miracles
- b. John in prison
 - he heard of Jesus teaching & works
 - John the Baptist sends 2 of his disciples to question Jesus
- c. John had doubts
 - Are you the coming one - Mt 3:11
 - * (the Messiah?) - Luke 3:15
 - * (that prophet?) - John 1:21
 - * (Elijah who is to come?) - Jn 1:25
- d. Jesus simply answers John's question
- e. Jesus not upset at question
 - Jesus not angry
 - Jesus not annoyed
- f. Jesus says, "God tell John..."
 - 2 John's disciples tells him what they heard Jesus said & saw what Jesus did
 - they became eyewitnesses to Jesus' work & came to Jesus own conclusions

2. Help for the Blind - Miracle

- a. They receive their sight

3. Help for the lame - Miracle

- a. They healed to walk - immediately

- no physical therapy
- no exercise to strengthen muscles

- b. Normal human physical processes take time to return to full strength

4. Help for the lepers - Miracle

- a. They are healed (cleansed)

- b. Leprosy destroys nerve endings

- nerves for pain, touch, etc
- nerves die & no feeling left

- eventually body parts fall off

5. Help for the Deaf - Miracle

- a. They hear sound

6. Help for the Dead - Miracle

- a. Raised back up to life

- b. Taken out of the grave
