1. Introduction

- a. First miracle of Jesus ministry
 - Located in Cana of Galilee
 - Changing water into wine at wedding feast
- b. Context
 - Jesus about 30 years old - Lk 3:23
 - Jesus baptized by John the Baptist
 - Jesus tempted by Satan in the wilderness - Mt 4, Mk 1, Lk 4
 - Jesus ministry began in Galilee
- c. Belief (faith) comes to Jesus disciples
 - Jn 1:40-41 Andrew called Jesus Messiah
 - Jn 1:43-45 Philip calls Jesus fulfillment of Moses & prophet professes prophecies

2. Mary's Request

- a. Mary tells her son Jesus about lack of wine (vs. 3)
- b. Jesus calls his mother "woman" once He started His ministry (vs 4)
- c. Mary told the servants to do whatever Jesus said (vs 5)
 - How did she know?
- d. Six huge ~~pot~~ stone pots (vs 6-7)
 - each pot = 20-30 gallons
 - total gallons about 120 gallons
- e. All pots filled to brim with water

3. Jesus' Miracle

- a. Jesus instructed servants to take some of it to the feast master (vs 8)
- b. Feast master called it the best wine at the marriage feast (vs 10)
- c. When did the water become wine?
 - in the pots?
 - in the feast master's hands?
 - unknown
- d. Servants knew source of wine (vs 9)
 - from WATER

3e) Jesus disciples saw His miracle

4) Looking At Jesus Response

a. Jn 2:4 "My hour has not yet come."

- approaching time in future
- Jesus knew when all things would happen to Him - Jn 18:4

- * approaching hour of death
- Jesus knew His hour had come
- Jn 13:1

b. Jesus knew His purpose

- "What does your concern have to do with Me?"

- * her notice of no wine
- * Jesus beginning ministry

5. Others' Response

a. Mary

- servants to follow Jesus commands

b. Servants followed His instructions

c. Feast master's reaction

- best wine ever
- * he didn't know the source

d. Servants in the know

- they had worked hard for some time filling those water pots

e. Word gets around quick among the common people
