1. Introduction

a. Jesus speaking

- "I am the vine (whole plant:
root system, stock, branches above)
- Jn 15:1 I am the true vine

b. All disciples of Jesus are compared
to branches

c. Vine can survive without branches

- ~~branch~~ new branches can grow
& replace those cut off

d. But branches cannot survive without
the vine

- cut off branches? they die

e. One vine, but many branches

2. Depend on God - Pray more

a. 1 Tim 2:1 first - supplications,
prayers, intercessions, thanksgiving

- all different forms of praying

- pray for all men

- pray for those in authority

b. Types of praying

- intercession: standing in between
* Christian intermediary for other
person before God

- supplication: suppliant person
asking for something
* have needs that need filling
(solutions)

- thanksgiving: telling God "Thank
you" for His goodness & filling
need

- prayers: catchall for talking
with God for everything else

c. Prayer reflects God's eternity

- Before: supplication

- During: intercession

- After (finish): thanksgiving

3. Depend on God - Be godly & honest
 - a. Christian lives quietly & peaceable
 - b. Government purpose to control criminal element (see Rom 13:1-6)
 - praying for government officials
 - want government officials to create peace & order in society
 - c. Christian lives orderly life socially in godliness & reverence to God
 - honesty in all parts of Christian life
 - d. In all societies, evil exists
 - evil lives in the heart of all humans, including Christians
 - ~~humans~~ some humans do evil things
4. God wants to save all people
 - a. Praying for others is good & acceptable in God's sight
 - God wants social conditions to be quiet & peaceable
 - God is not the God of evils, violence, or unsettled conditions
 - b. God desires for all people to be saved
 - God's gift of goodness to all people (Mt 7:11)
 - Easier to spread gospel of Christ when your neighborhood has peace & quiet
 - c. God gives out knowledge of the truth
 - peacefulness & quiet is part of truth that God gives
 - God is opposed to evil & violence
 - only God can give peace within the heart (inside self)
 - only God can forgive sin
 - * sin is evil against God & His moral laws (10 commandments)
 - d. God's gospel
 - 1 Tim 2:5-6 One Mediator who paid ransom for sins - Man Christ Jesus
