1. Introduction

- a. "Do to others as you would want to happen to you." -

- this is the Law & the Prophets

- b. Mt 22:36-40 All the law & prophets based on the greatest commands of all - loving God & loving your neighbor

2. God wants you to think

- a. Stop before you think something through - look for Bible principles

- b. Stop before you speak

- c. Stop before you do something

- d. Basic core: how do I want others to treat me?

- empathy = putting yourself in someone else's situation

- compassion: moved with empathy (sympathy) to act

- e. Give out kindness

- in your voice

- in your body language

- in your actions

- f. God's principle in life

- be engaged in person's life

- participate in lives of other people

- Mt 5:16 let your light shine...

* others can see your good works

* they will glorify heavenly Father

3. Then do to others

- a. Rule of thumb: the way (manner) that you want to be treated

- b. "Love your neighbor as yourself"

- Mt 19:19

4. Because God wants this

- a. This is God's desire

- b. "God is love" 1 Jn 4:16

- God's love is bounded (surrounded)
by justice

- c. Show others that God is Love because you love others

- showing love with kindness

- 4d. Body language agrees with your words
- say "I love you" with sour face?
 - other person thinks, "I don't want to listen to them."
 - other person thinks, "I want to get away from them."
 - give kind words with a smile

5. Conclusion

- a. Jn 15:1 Jesus is the true vine
 - God the Father is the caretaker (husbandman) of the vine
 - Stay connected with God
- b. Jn 15:2 God (purges) prunes the branches
 - pruning in life is painful
 - but God's pruning creates more fruit in your life
- c. Jn 15:5 Staying in God's love
 - "Abide (stay) in Me" - Jesus speaking
 - Mt 5:44 Love your enemies - bless them, do good to them, pray for them
 - Jn 13:35 all will know that Christians are Jesus' disciples loving each other
 - Jn 15:9 continue in God's love
 - Rom 13:9-10 Law understood with one saying, "Love your neighbor as yourself"

* love does no evil to their neighbor
- d. Jn 15:7-8
 - Stay inside love of Jesus - abide

 - Ask (pray) what you will
 - Live as Jesus' disciples
