1. Introduction
 - a. Family needs teachers in the home
 - some groups with an agenda focused on teaching youth
 - jesuits train child for first 7 years
 - b. Train up child in way they should go. And when old, they won't depart } Prov 22:6
 - according to Jewish rabbi, depart meaning cannot escape the teaching
 - parable of Prodigal Son, example - Lk 15 of not escaping his childhood teaching
 - c. ~~Four~~ Foundational principles of teaching
2. Principle of Acknowledgement
 - a. There is one God (6:4) } (Is 45:12-15)
 - Lucifer rebelled against one God
 - not many gods, or (1 Cor 8:4-6)
 - not no god (Ps 14:1, 53:1)
 - "serpant beguiled Eve" (Gen 3:1, 2 Cor 11:3)
 - b. One sovereign God
 - Deut 4:33-35 Lord Himself is God - none other
 - Is 45:6-7, 12, 18 He is God, Creator, none other
 - One Redeemer, one savior (Pet 3:18, Heb 9:12, 16)
 - c. One premier affection
 - love the Lord your God with everything
 - 1 Jn 4:8 God is love
3. Principle of Powerful Authority
 - a. Teach these words them carefully to your children
 - b. Authority comes from conviction
 - conviction from the heart
 - these words shall be in parent's heart
 - all parental authority in the Scriptures
 - c. Content of teaching
 - the Lord God is one God (Mk 12:32)
 - human person to love the Lord your God with all your heart
4. Principle of Planned Affirmation
 - a. Bring scripture into every part of family life

 - when you travel
 - when you go to bed
 - when you wake up
 - bring God & your love of God into every conversation
- c. Parent responsibility
- bring up your children in nurture & admonition of the Lord (Eph 6:4)
