1. Introduction

- book of Moses - Deuteronomy
- Why is there evil?
 - evil can come from one person
 - evil can come from group of people or even from country controlled by evil person(s)

c. Habakkuk written by prophet in Judah probably during reign of Manasseh / and/or sons of Josiah

d. Book of Job records Job experience with evil, sorrow, & grief (Job 19:23-27)

2. How Long? (1:2)

a. Epicurus ancient Greek philosopher

had questions - 350 BC

- questions about God & evil
 - * God willing to prevent evil?
 - * God not able to stop evil?
 - * Not willing or able, why call Him God?

b. Habakkuk crying about evil & injustice in kingdom of Judah

c. Violence everywhere

3. Why God Not Listening? (1:3-4)

a. God, you're not listening

b. God, you will not save

c. God, you're doing nothing

4. Habakkuk's Burden

a. Sin & evil everywhere

b. No justice found

c. Wicked people everywhere

5. What is God's Plan (1:5)

a. God is sovereign

- God still rules

- God is still in control

- How? (~~How~~ (1:12-14))

* God created everything - very good

* But humans (Adam & Eve) invited evil (serpent/Satan) into world

5a (cont'd) Hab 2:4-5

- * Evil? Satan
- * Satan's sin started in heaven
 - * Ezek 28:14-15
 - * Is 14:12-15 Lucifer chose #5
 - "I will's" saying these inside himself

b. God will judge (1:6-11)

- God says "Watch" (2:2-3)
- God will raise up judgement from outside the nation to stop Judea's evil
- God gives the name of coming conquering nation
 - * God gave name of country to King Hezekiah (2 Kings 20:12-18, Is. 39:1-7)
 - * God gave name to prophet Jeremiah (Jer 20:4-5, 21:3-10)
 - * God gave kingdom of Judea warning many years after years
 - * God wanted Judea to repent & turn from their sins
 - * God warned Judea 3 times

c. God will Redeem

a. What is providence?

- God will provide.
- God who sees
 - * Latin word pro+videre = see before

b. God simply tells Habakkuk to "Write the vision"

- these writings are in the scriptures in the Old Testament
- God next tells prophet to make it plain (easy to understand)

c. God warns the prophet that this warning is yet for an appointed time

- Hab 2:1-3
- * Vision does not lie
 - * Vision will surely come
