1. Introduction

- a. Demon possession takes many strange forms
 - in this case, man could not speak
 - Jesus leaves home after healing 2 blind men
 - Jesus is back in city streets
- b. Some people in crowd brought demon possessed man to Jesus
- c. Jesus removes demon from man's life
- d. Demon leaves, man speaks
 - demon was cause of man not speaking
 - people knew difference between medical problem & demon possession

2. "Dumb" (Mute) Man Had Demon

- a. Old English word does not mean stupid
 - in this case, "dumb" means mute (not able to speak)
- b. Another case where demon caused blind & unable to speak (Mt 12:22)
- c. Another time demons in herd of pigs caused crazy insane behavior (Mt 8:31-32)
 - pig herd did not follow normal instincts of pig behavior
 - Jesus understood all about demons
 - demons cannot do anything without Jesus' permission
- d. Bible instructs all Christians to "test every spirit" (1 Jn 4:1-3)
 - many false prophets in world
 - test question: "Has Jesus come (born) in the flesh?"
* means: Is Jesus Christ human?
- e. Demon possession is not psychological problem or mental illness

3. Jesus Throws Out Demon
- a. Demon thrown out of man
 - b. Now man can speak
 - c. Everyone in crowd in shock
 - positive reaction from crowd
 - this kind of action not seen in Israel

4. Multitudes Marveled
- a. Common people in crowd often surprised in good way to Jesus' good works
 - Mt 12:23 Another time in similar situation
 - Crowd starts to pay attention to Jesus' teaching
 - b. They notice how Jesus is different from other rabbis & teachers

5. Pharisees Blasphemed
- a. But pharisees teachers of Jewish religious laws in Israel
 - b. They were beyond skeptical
 - they were hostile to Jesus ministry
 - c. They claimed Jesus power came from the head power ruler of demons
 - compare similar situation (Mt 12:24)
 - d. Pharisees as a group did not want to say that Jesus power came from God
 - e. Pharisees likely saw Jesus in competition to their status as religious leaders
 - f. Look at divide between Jesus teaching & their teaching
 - Nicodemus in John 3:1-21 - LIVING FAITH
 - * "You must be born again"
 - * Pharisee teaching, "Observe these religious rituals" - DEAD FAITH

6. Jesus Continued
- a. Jesus continued in His ministry of teaching & preaching
 - He continued healing people in need
 - b. Jesus did not pause or stop His ministry
