

1. Introduction
 - a. Important to have faith in God
 - b. God demands faith as foundation
 - Heb 11:1 faith is substance & evidence
 - Heb 11:6 faith: believe God lives & rewards
 - c. Immediately after Feeding of 5000
 - Jesus sent the crowds away
 - Jesus sent His disciples in a boat to cross over Sea of Galilee to other side
 - d. Jesus went up on a mountain to pray alone
 - Sun is setting at evening
 - e. Roman "watches" - Keeping time
 - 1st watch = 6P-9P
 - 2nd watch = 9P-12 Midnight
 - 3rd watch = 12 Midnight - 3A
 - 4th watch = 3AM-6 AM
2. Jesus Prays Alone
 - a. Disciples obeyed Jesus
 - disciples in God's will in their journey by boat
 - they in aftermath of glow of Jesus feeding huge crowd
 - b. Jesus spent afternoon praying alone
 - He spent most of the night praying
3. Disciples Have Trouble
 - a. Wind started blowing
 - b. Boat tossed around by the wind
 - c. They were in the middle of the water far from shore
 - d. Wind blowing against them
4. Jesus Comes to His Disciples
 - a. When? in the 4th watch
 - in the early morning hours while dark

- 4 b. Jesus comes to disciples walking on the water
- How? walking on water?
 - And Jesus didn't sink
 - Jesus walking on water like it was hard ground
 - this all happened after 3 AM
- c. Scene out of a living nightmare
- It is dark & waves pushing boat around
 - they think they see a man walking in the waves
 - the man not getting knocked over
- d. Disciples afraid at this abnormal sight
- sight against all laws of physics
 - Conclusion: "It's a ghost!"
- e. Jesus comforts them
- "It's only me." "Don't be afraid."
5. Peter Asks to Join Jesus
- a. Peter, "If it's you, tell me..."
 - b. Peter wants to come to Jesus outside the boat
 - c. Peter is not asking to swim
 - d. Peter wants to walk outside the boat to Jesus
 - Peter is man of action
6. Jesus Commands Peter
- a. Simple word, "Come!"
 - b. Peter starts walking on water
 - c. But then Peter starts seeing his surroundings - wind & waves
 - d. Peter gets afraid
 - e. Peter knew who to call for help
 - "Lord, save me!"
 - Peter was slowly sinking into the water
7. Jesus Saves Peter
- a. Jesus touches Peter caught him by his hand
 - b. Jesus, "Why did you doubt..."
 - c. Wind stopped when both in boat
