1. Introduction

- a. Is God sufficient for you?
 - Is God enough for you?
- b. Name of Jesus given to Him
 - Mt 1:20-21 given to Joseph in a dream
 - Lk 1:31 told by angel Gabriel to Mary
 - Lk 2:11 angel did not tell shepherds
 - * only that Messiah was born
 - Lk 2:21 when Jesus was circumcized at 8 days old, He received His name Jesus
 - Mt 1:25 Joseph gave Him the name of Jesus

2. This Christmas is for all people

- a. "Good tidings of great joy (vs 10)
 - best news of all
- b. "to all people" for everyone
 - good news sent first to poor shepherds
 - * they heard the news gladly (Lk 2:15)
 - * they easily accepted God's news
- c. Mat 1:11 My name shall be great among the Gentiles... My name shall be great among the heathen nations
 - Ps 72:17 His name shall endure forever... all nations shall call Him blessed

- d. Acts 4:12 no other name... whereby we must be saved

- e. Titus 2:11 has appeared to all men

3. This Christmas was in Bethlehem

- a. Savior born in City of David (vs.14)
- b. Lk 2:4 City of David - Bethlehem

3 c. Mt 2:4-6 Where is Christ to be born?

- in Bethlehem of Judea (Mt 2:4-5)
- Mt 2:6 quotation from Micah 5:2
 - * Ruler to shepherd God's people

4. This Christmas was birth of Christ the Lord

a. Israel waited over 400 years to see birth of the Christ Messiah

- no prophecies (scriptures) given since 2nd temple built
- * last prophecies of Zechariah, Haggai, & Malachi

b. Historical time periods

- Persian Empire rule
- Maccabean independence
- Roman rule starting 40 BC
 - * relatively recent within one generation
