1. Introduction

- a. Parallel accounts: Mt 26:47-56;
Mk 14:43-50; Jn 18:1-13
- Jn 18:10 Peter takes his sword
out & cut of Malchus right ear
* Malchus servant of high priest
- b. Judas betrays Jesus in Garden of
Gethsemane (Judas Iscariot)
- Lk 22:1-7 Satan enters (possesses)
Judas Iscariot
- Mt 26:3-5; Mk 14:1-2; 10-11; Jn 13:2, 27-30
- c. Caiaphas High Priest prophesied that
better for one man to die for the
people rather than the nation perish
(Jn 11:47-53)
- d. Jesus experiences His greatest
spiritual agony in Garden of
Gethsemane (Lk 22:39-46)

2. Fake Disciple Arrives

- a. Judas surnamed Iscariot (Lk 22:3)
- son of Simon (Jn 12:4)
- b. = one of the 12 Disciples (Lk 12:47)
- b. Judas met armed guard in temple
area to lead them into Garden of
Gethsemane (Jn 18:2-3)
- c. Apostle John understood Judas
Iscariot (Jn ~~12~~ 12:4-6)
- Judas Iscariot was a thief
* he carried group's money box
* he used group's money for his
own personal benefit
- d. Judas paid by high priest & chief
priests for 30 pieces of silver
- price of slave
- prophesied in Old Testament (Ze
(Zechariah 11:10-13)
- Mt 26:14-16
- Judas Iscariot didn't support Jesus

3. Peter's Grand Statement

a. Peter as loose cannon

- ~~He~~ He boasts that he was ready to go to prison or death for ~~prison~~ Jesus (Lk 22:33)
- Jesus warns Peter that Satan has asked to twist him into a pretzel (Lk 22:31)
- Jesus prayed that Peter's faith won't fail (Lk 22:32)
- Jesus also tells Peter that he will deny Him 3 times that night (Mt 26:34)

b. Disciples Big Problem

- "Who will be the greatest?" (Mt 22:24)

- Be as servant (~~at~~ Lk 22:27)

c. Jesus example of service

- He washes their feet (Jn 13:3-5)
- ~~stop~~ - Peter wants to jump in with 2 feet
* wash me all over (Jn 13:8-10)
- Jesus example of servant leader (Jn 13:15-17)

4. Jesus Encounter in Garden

a. Disciples bring 2 swords (Lk 22:38)

b. "Shall we fight?" (Lk 22:49)

c. One of the disciples cut off right ear of High Priest's servant (Lk 22:50)

- Jn identifies both by name (Jn 18:10)
* Peter cut off Malchus ear

d. Jesus asks Malchus permission

- "permit even this" (Lk 22:51)
- Jesus simply touches Malchus' ear

e. Jesus asks the guards to let His disciples leave

- "Let these go their way." (Jn 18:8)

f. All of Jesus' disciples fled for their lives (Mt 26:56; Mk 14:50)
