1. Introduction

- a. Parallel accounts: Mk 16:1-8,
Lk 24:1-11, Jn 20:1-13
- b. Miracle of Jesus raising up out
of the grave into life by himself
- c. Focus on verses 5-6
- d. Words used: "he has risen",
resurrection, "he arose", "he is
risen"
- Jn 10:15, 17-18 Jesus speaking,
"I lay down My life of Myself"
"I have power to take it again."
- Jn 19:10-11 Pilate, "I have power
to crucify You." Jesus, "You could
have no power... unless it had been
given to you from above."

2. ~~Jesus Rose Alive from the Dead~~

Ladies seek the Lord on the Lord's
Day

- a. What is the Lord's Day
- on the first day of the week
- SUNDAY
- b. Women wanted to honor Jesus
in death
- anoint His body with spices
- c. Where were the men His disciples?
- Jn 20:19 hiding in a locked room
- d. Mary Magdalene mentioned by name
in all 4 gospels on Resurrection Sunday
- e. Women asked, "who will roll away
the stone?" (Mk 16:3)

3. Angel rolled ~~away~~ away stone from
entrance to tomb

- a. Did Jesus need stone rolled away?
- No
- b. Why stone rolled away?
- for women & others to see the
empty tomb
- c. What happened before women came?
- earthquake with lots of shaking
ground

- 3d. What did angel find at the tomb?
- temple soldiers guarding the tomb
 - they already scared from earthquake
 - they shook with fear & scared out of their minds
 - they ran away to the temple

e. Women meet the angel sitting on the stone
- women meet Jesus first before the men

4. Jesus Appeared on Lord's Day

- In week before He died, Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead
- Women came to the tomb expecting a dead body
- Angel tells women that he knows that women looking for Jesus who was crucified (dead)
 - Good news
 - * "He is not here."
 - * "He is risen." (Alive!)
 - * "Come & see where He used to lay [in the tomb]."

d. Message for the disciples

- "Jesus is risen"
- "Meet Jesus in Galilee"

5. Jesus meets the women on the road

- Women ran to tell the disciples
- Jesus meets them & says, "Rejoice."
- Women held His feet & worshipped Him

6. Jesus, Twelve Disciples & Others

- Judas Iscariot killed himself
 - Acts 1:16-18
- Eleven remaining disciples meet Jesus again in Galilee at an appointed mountain location
 - they worshipped Jesus but some still had doubts (Mt 28:16-17)
- * Jesus was seen by over 500 people at one time (1 Cor 15:6)

7. Great Commission

- Jesus has all power in heaven & on earth
- Great Commission: Go, teach, baptizing
