1. Introduction

- a. Ruth 4:14 kinsman redeemer
 - kinfolk: blood relatives
 - redeemer: ancient practice in land ownership to keep land in the family by marrying family's brother's widow

b. Applied sense to Jesus in prophecy

- Jesus born into this world to redeem His people from their sin
- In 1:11 He came to His own [people] but His own didn't receive Him

c. Law of kinsman redeeming the land (Lev 25:23-27)

d. Theme of book of Ruth: story of love & redemption

- redemption: to buy back
- Lev 25:47-54 buying relative out of slavery

2. Lord Almighty can do all things

a. Backstory sets the scene (Ruth 1:1-5)

- famine in Israel
- Elimelech & wife Naomi go to Moab with their 2 sons
- Naomi's husband dies
- 2 sons take Moabite wives
- 2 sons die without children

b. Naomi decides to return to Israel

- Ruth 1:6-9
- Her 2 daughter-in-laws follow her
- She asks them to return home

c. Naomi has no more other sons for them to marry

d. Back & forth between the women

- Ruth 1:10-14

- 2 e. God permitted men in Naomi's family to all die in Moab
- 3 widow women left alone
 - Naomi's sorrows ("call me Mara ("bitter"))" afflictions (1:20)
3. Lord is Lord God of Israel
- a. Lord God is with His people
 - He is trustworthy
 - He blesses His people
 - b. Ruth chooses Naomi (1:16)
 - "Your people shall be my people, & your God, my God"
 - c. Naomi returns to Bethlehem with her daughter-in-law Ruth
 - d. Boaz is relative of Naomi's dead husband Elimelech (2:1, 3-4)
 - e. Ruth goes gleaning (picking up leftovers) in field of grain
 - happens to be farm of Boaz
 - gleaning way for poor people to work for grain
 - Ruth goes out to glean grain with Naomi's permission
 - Ruth recognized as caring for Naomi
 - She continued in same farm for entire harvest season (2:7-13)
 - * with Boaz permission
 - * with Naomi's guidance
 - f. God's care for Ruth
 - God brought Ruth to Boaz notice
 - (Ruth 2:14-17)
 - Boaz even instructed his workers to purposely let extra fall down
4. Naomi plans future for Ruth
- a. Ruth 3:1-18
 - b. Naomi tells Ruth about exercising custom of land redemption & her future (Boaz, unmarried)
5. Boaz exercises his right of kinsman redeemer (Ruth 4:1-13)
- a. Legal requirements (Ruth 4:3-6)
 - b. Boaz exercises his rights to buy (Ruth 4:9-13)
