1. Introduction

- a. Life of Moses as written in book of Hebrews
- b. Life is full of choices
 - approve excellent things
 - direct life with intention
 - Christian living is not an accident, but a choice
 - change is a choice
- c. Moses made several choices that changed his life

2. Purpose

- a. Choose between temporal & eternal
 - life with purpose - forward direction
 - life of victimhood - looking backwards in rear view mirror
- b. Moses as grown man
 - did not choose to live as son of Pharaoh's daughter
 - chose side of Hebrew people
 - Moses raised in knowledge & riches & power of Egyptian ruling house
 - Moses paid a price for his choice

3. Purpose & Facing Fears

- a. Moses left Egypt by faith
 - he went into the wilderness alone
 - he wasn't afraid of King's anger

4. Purpose in Leadership
- Passing through the Red Sea
 - Children of Israel murmured (complained) about Moses' leadership
 - God conforms Christian into His image through trials

5. Purpose Helps With Eternal Perspective

- Moses chose "reproach of Christ"
 - suffering with people of Israel
- Moses looked for God's reward
 - God's riches greater riches than Egypt's treasures
- Moses valued "Christ's reproach"
 - rather than temporary pleasures of sin

6. ~~pt.~~ Patterns in Moses life

- Moses lived 40 years in Egyptian luxury & training
- Moses lived in the desert 40 years herding sheep
- Moses leader of Israel for 40 years in the Sinai desert
