- Acronym naming themes
- B = Bible authority
- A = Autonomy - self rule
- P = Priesthood of Christian
- T = Two offices
- I = Individual soul liberty
- S = Separation of church & state
- T = Two ordinances

a. common word

- b. Also called Scriptures, Word of God, "Law & the Prophets"
 - also called "God breathed"; inspired Scripture (2 Tim 3:16)
 - 2 Pet 1:20-21 prophecy of Scripture moved by Holy Spirit
 - LK 24:27 Moses (the Law) & the prophets the Scriptures concerning Himself (Jesus)
 - Heb 4:12 as a cutting sword

3. Autonomy

a. Self ruled local church

- church is independent
- local church rules itself

b. Historical sense

- democracy in local church
- ruled by congregation & church officers according to Bible
- Jesus, Under Shepherd pastor, [Elder(s)], deacons, Christian members

4. Priesthood of each believer

- a. Every Christian can go directly to Jesus Christ directly
- b. Jesus Christ is only Mediator (1 Tim 2:5)
between God the Father & Christian
- c. Every Christian a holy priesthood as living stones in spiritual house (1 Pet 2:5)
- d. One Mediator only
 - 1 Tim 2:5 man christ Jesus
 - Heb 4:14, 16 Jesus son of God, great High Priest come boldly

- a. Bishop (elder), presbyter, pastor
 - senior leader(s)
 - qualifications (1 Tim 3:1-7)
- b. Deacons
 - servant leaders, "table servers"
 - qualifications (1 Tim 3:8-13)
