1. Introduction

- b. Context about prayer (vs. 9-11)
 - relation of father to children
- c. Prayer is key to unlock door to heavenly Father
- d. Compare to Lord's Prayer (6:9-13)
 - how to not pray (Mt 6:7-8)

2. Promise to Prayer

- a. Access to God's divine ~~power~~ ^{POWER} prayer
 - Mt 6:8 Father knows your needs before you ask
 - Jms 1:5 ask for wisdom
- b. Jms 4:2 ~~as~~ you don't have because you don't ask

c. Fellowship factor

- God wants you to know Him
- ~~book~~ Knowing God, by JI Packer
- starts with accepting Jesus of Nazareth is your life
- Heavenly Father Mt 6:9

d. Development factor

- 1 Pet 2:2-3 newborn babies grow

e. Dependence factor

- Ask, seeks, know
- will be given, will find, will be opened
- heavenly Father gives good things to those who ask (7:11)

3. Process to Follow

- a. Progress in prayer
 - ask → seek → find
- b. Express to God your desire
 - God commands Christian to pray
 - prayer expresses Christian dependence on God
- c. Entreat (beg) God for direction
 - seek = looking for direction
 - Acts 16: 6-10 Paul tried to go in various directions
 - * forbidden, forbidden, then conclusion after vision to go west
 - Jms 5: 16 effective fervent prayer of righteous man avails much
- d. Engage God with determination
 - knocking to open a door
 - * continue knocking
 - * Lk 11: 5-10 persistence continually knocking

4. Provision to Receive

- a. God will respond
 - to him who knocks, it will be opened
- b. Jn 16: 24 ask and you will receive that your joy may be full
- c. God answers prayer presently
- d. God answers prayer paternally (as a father)
 - Mt 7: 11 how much more heavenly Father gives good things

5. Principle to Follow

- a. God's Golden Rule (Mt 7: 12)
 - the Law & the Prophets (Scripture)
 - whatever you want men to do to you, do also to them
- b. Power of Holy Spirit (Lk 11: 13)
 - parallel verses (Lk 11: 9-12)
 - how much more will heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him
 - * will of the Lord (Eph 5: 17-20)
 - * be filled with Holy Spirit
 - Acts 2: 1-3 First time baptized in Holy Spirit
 - Acts 2: 4-40 filled with Holy Spirit
