(Hebrews 2:9-10)

TWO WAYS OF GOD RENEWS

1. His Word (Scripture)

"Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."
(John 17:17)

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." (Colossians 3:16)

2. His Spirit

"Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. 14 He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you." (John 16:13-14)

"That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost." (Romans 15:16)

Quote: "Jesus has gone to prepare a place for us, and the Holy Spirit has been sent to prepare us for that place."

3. OUTWARD Working in Life (v. 12b)

Quote: "The principle Paul laid down is this: God must work in us before He can work through us. ... Too many Christians obey God only because of pressure on the outside, and not power on the inside."—Warren Wiersbe

HOW TO WORK OUT

1. Read Scripture / read Bible

"As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: 3 If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious." (1 Peter 2:2)

"The words of the LORD are pure words: As silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. 7 Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, Thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever." (Psalm 12:6-7)

2. Prayer / talking with God

"Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. 7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:6-7)

3. Witness For Christ / tell others about Jesus

"And many of the brethren in the Lord, waxing confident by my bonds, are much more bold to speak the word without fear." (Philippians 1:14)

4. Fellowship With Believers / spend time with Christians "And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine

and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers."
(Acts 2:42)

"Only Luke is with me. Take Mark, and bring him with thee: for he is profitable to me for the ministry." (2 Timothy 4:11)

5. Obey Christ / follow commands of Tesus

"If ye <u>keep my commandments</u>, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love." (John 15:10)
