1. AN INWARD Strength (v. 1)

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." (Philippians 4:13)

"Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might." (Ephesians 6:10)

SAVING GRACE

"Being <u>justified freely</u> by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:" (Romans 3:24)

SANCTIFYING GRACE

"For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, 12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;" (Titus 2:11-12)

B. The supply of Grace from Holy Spirit GRACE TO STAND & Piritually

"Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: 2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God." (Romans 5:1-2)

"But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me." (1 Corinthians 15:10)

GRACE TO SERVE God

"And this word, Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain. 28 Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:"

GRACE FOR SUFFERING spiritually or physically

2. AN OUTWARD Message (v.2) tell others

SOME ARE ENTANGLED IN CULTURAL COMPROMISE

"Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints." (Jude 1:3)

C. A sensitive Stand - pleasing to God

"For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ." (Galatians 1:10)
