1. Introduction

a. context: humans became fools
when they did not glorify God

b. continuing theme

- they did not glorify God
- they were not thankful
- they did not like to retain God
in their knowledge
- they rejected God

c. Humans ~~have~~ fallen nature

- there is none righteous (Rom 3:10)
- there is none who does good (Rom 3:12)

2. Perversion of TRUTH (vs 24-25)

a. Humans changed truth of God
for the lie

b. God gave humans up to uncleanness
- gave them up to dishonor their
bodies among themselves

c. How do humans change God's truth

- sexual perversion - change natural use
- spiritual perversion - false gods
- Hab 2:18-19 teacher of lies
- forsaking God, forsaking truth

d. Worship creation

- humans served the creature(s)
- animals valued more than humans
* Ps 81:9-12

3. Perversion in Sin (vs. 26-27)

- a. God gives humans to vile affections (passions)
 - practice: humans exchanging natural use against nature
 - * no reproductive capacity (men with men, women with women)
 - * against biology (nature)
 - x puberty blockers
 - x sexual hormones of opposite sex
 - x surgery to remove sexual organs
 - x Bible calls them eunuchs
 - * even animals understand reproduction drives

b. God's design

- God created male & female
- God created marriage/family
- children best protected inside intact families

c. Natural Consequences

- receive something in themselves penalty of their errors
 - * defy physical laws of nature?
 - x jump off cliff? You fall & die
 - * x do practices in biology in parts of body not designed for use? body becomes inflamed or diseased
- 1 Cor 6:18 Flee fornication - sinning against their own body in sexual immorality

4. Persistence in Unbelief (vs. 28)

- a. Willful turning
 - they did not like to retain God in their mind/knowledge
 - from willful perversion turns to moral perversion
 - Prov 13:28-32 hated fear of the Lord
- b. Witnessed by God
 - God turned them over to debased (reprobate) mind
 - Gal 6:7 God is not mocked - what you sow (plant), you shall reap (harvest)
