C. Why We Pray

FOR QUIET

Quote: "The word 'quiet' carries the idea of the absence of outside disturbance. The word 'peaceable' carries the idea of the absence of inside disturbance or turbulence."-John MacArthur

2. THE Purpose OF GOD (v. 3-4)

A. The galvation of All see 1 Tim 1:15

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should faithful perish, but that all should come to repentance." (2 Peter 3:9)
