 - vs 1-3 God's temple
 - * longing for the living God
 - vs. 7 going from strength to strength
 - * appearing before God
- c. Ps 23:4 Valley of shadow of death

1. For Christians, Trouble Always Tempered by Time
 - a. Job example of patience in trouble
 - Jms 5:11 patience of Job
 - b. Job God's servant
 - Job 1:8 upright man fearing God
 - c. Satan cause of Job's problems (Job 1:12)
 - Job 1:14-15, all wealth taken
16-17
 - Job 1:18-19 all his children dead
 - Job 2:7 his health goes bad

2. Devotion Developed by Duty

- a. Do not forsake assembling together (Heb 10:25)
 - go to church on regular basis
 - so much the more as you see Day of Jesus' coming again
- b. Job worships God
 - Job 1:21
- c. Job does not falsely accuse God
 - Job 1:22; 2:10; 42:7

3. Opportunity Always Arises With Opposition

- a. Human trouble is God's opportunity
- b. Job truthfully trust God
 - Job 2:3, 10

4. Job comes closer to God

- Job 42:4-6 now Job sees God & repents
- Job 42:8 God accepts Job (not his 3 friends)
