1. Introduction

- a. God calls Barnabas & Saul (Paul) to special ministry to the Gentiles (13:1)
- b. God opened door to Gentiles of faith in God (14:22) (14:27)
- c. God sent Barnabas & Saul to start new churches
- d. Church founded by Jesus Christ & the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:2-4)
 - also called body of Christ
 - also called bride of Christ
- e. Church is the agency to send missionaries to start new churches
- f. What is a church?
 - called out assembly of Christians
- g. Three principles

2. Through Supplication

- a. Prayer
 - church at Antioch ministered to the Lord
 - they fasted & prayed
- b. Fasting
 - refraining from eating to concentrate on praying to God
 - Ps 35:13; Dan 9:3; 1 Cor 7:5

3. Through Sacrifice

- a. God calls people to ministry
 - Christian brothers
 - Saul & Barnabas called to ministry

3 b. Church gave their resources

- they sent Barnabas & Saul
- example - church at Phillipi
 - * Phil 4:16-19
 - * 2 Cor 8:1-4 churches of Macedonia

c. Barnabas & Saul return to Antioch

- report card
 - * told Christians everything
 - * told of God opening door to Gentiles (also see Acts 11:1, 18, 15:7)

4. Through Steadfastness

a. Church assembled together in Antioch

- Acts 11:25-26
 - * Barnabas brings Saul to Antioch
 - * They were in church for 1 year
 - * Christians first Disciples first called Christians in Antioch

- Acts 11:19-21 Jewish Christians reached out to Gentile Hellenists
 - * first multicultural church

b. To report the results

- Saul & Barnabas rehearsed their speech to the church in Antioch
 - * they gave their report

c. Gal 6:9 not be weary in well doing

d. What is steadfastness?

- to continue doing good
- no quitting - not faint hearted
- regular doing well
