Text: 2 Corinthians 8:1-9

"Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia; 2 How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality. 3 For to their power, I bear record, yea, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves; 4 Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. 5 And this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God. 6 Insomuch that we desired Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also finish in you the same grace also. 7 Therefore, as ye abound in every thing, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that ye abound in this grace also. 8 I speak not by commandment, but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your love. 9 For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich." 2 BASIC STEWARDSHIP CONVICTIONS

I. God is Owner (of all things)

"For every beast of the forest is mine, and the cattle upon a thousand hills. 11 I know all the fowls of the mountains: and the wild beasts of the field are mine. 12 If I were hungry, I would not tell thee: for the world is mine, and the fulness thereof." (Psalm 50:10-12)

2. We are Stewards (coretaker)

"Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful." (1 Corinthians 4:2)

1. A BESTOWED Grace (from God) (v. 1)

A. His Grace <u>saved</u> Us

"Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:" (Romans 3:24)

"For by grace are you saved..." (Ephesians 2:8-9)

"Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift." (2 Corinthians 9:15)

B. His Grace sustains Us (supports)
PHYSICALLY (health)

"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:" (2 Corinthians 9:8)

FINANCIALLY (money)

"What shall I render unto the LORD for all his benefits towards me?" (Psalm 116:12)

"I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD. 18 I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people." (Psalm 116:17–18)

2. A COMPLETE Surrender

A. A personal Surrender
