1. Introduction

a. In 13:35 love one another?

- all will know that you are a Christian

b. What is courageous?

- having courage, brave, strength in face of difficulty or danger

c. Man with dropsy

- swelling in legs or arms
- due to heart, liver, or kidney diseases
- or swelling due to malnutrition (long time no food)

d. Unusual for sick man invited to dinner with Pharisees

2. Jesus Sees the Heart

a. Did Moses say, "lawful to heal on Sabbath Day?" - question by Jesus

- Sabbath: day of worship on Saturday

b. Jesus saw the sick man

c. Pharisees knew Jesus could heal sick people

d. Basic Law - 10 commandments

- 4th Command: Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy

* 7th day is Sabbath of the Lord

→ Exod 20:8-11 Six days to work

- Mt 12:8 Son of Man Lord of Sabbath

- MK 2:27 Sabbath was made for (benefit of) man

* man not made for the Sabbath

3. Trap from Pharisees

- a. Pharisees stay silent - not one word
 - they want to accuse Jesus of healing (working) on Sabbath

- b. Jesus heals sick man

- Jesus sent man on his way

4. Jesus Reason for Healing

- a. Donkey or oxen cattle fall into pit?

- Animal cannot get out
 - All people (everyone) helps to pull animal out of pit
 - No one wants animal to get thirsty or hungry

- b. How does God see people compared to animals?

- Mt 10:31 Don't be afraid. You are of more value than many sparrow birds

- c. Pharisees could not answer Jesus
