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## 1. Introduction

- a. James makes reference to Elijah in 1 Kings chap 17-18
  - he served while King Ahab in northern kingdom in Israel
  - Israel worshiped false gods

- b. Baal Canaanite god served as fertility god & storm god
  - mythology son of chief god El & Asherah goddess of the sea.

## 2. Righteous Purpose

- a. History (1 Kings 17:1 no rain for 3 years)
  - 1 Kings 18:1 God will send rain again
- b. Unwavering obedience
  - 1 Kings 18:36 Elijah declares the God of Abraham, Isaac, Israel - Elijah obeyed.
  - supplication without surrender is not covr

## c. Unparalleled Objective

- 1 Kings 18:37 God is the Lord & turn your heart back to God

## 3. Rigorous Preparation

- a. Learning to trust solidarity
  - 1 Kings 17:2-7 God sends Elijah to brook Cherith (flows into Jordan River)
  - ravens brought meat & bread to him twice a day
  - he was alone with God & the ravens

### 3b. Learning to trust submissively

- 1 Kings 17:8-16
  - \* Widow of Zarephath in Sidon (gentile city)
  - \* she only had one last meal left
  - \* she obeyed the prophet to give him her last food
  - \* but God continued to supply her food for her family & Elijah

### c. Learning to trust singularly

- Zarephath widow's son died
  - 1 Kings 17:17-24
    - \* in her grief she complained to Elijah
    - \* Elijah took boy's body into upper room
    - \* Elijah cried out to God 3 times
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    - \* God heard Elijah & restored boy back to life
    - widow woman declares that now she knows is man of God & the Lord's word in his mouth is true

### 4. Railing Provocation

- a. Accusing charge
  - 1 Kings 18:17 Ahab calls Elijah "Troubler of Israel"
    - \* Ahab's family forsaken God
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  - Righteous courage stirs sinful opposition
    - \* Ahab blamed Elijah for the troubles (Ahab's fault)

- b. Arranged contest
  - 1 Kings 18:19-38 One prophet (Elijah) against 450 priests of Baal

### 5. Rare Power

- a. Pretense (1 Kings 18:25-29)
  - priests of Baal worked all day
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- b. Preparation (1 Kings 18:30-38)
  - Elijah built alter, offered sacrifice
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  - God answered him with fire
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  - God answered him with fire
- c. Prayer (1 Kings 18:36-37)
- d. Pre-eminence (1 Kings 18:38-39)
- e. Purging (1 Kings 18:40-41)
  - Kill all priests of Baal
