1. Introduction

- a. Difference between Christianity & other religions
 - other religions idea of salvation
 - salvation earned by good works
- b. - Christianity based on Christ's death on the cross & rising back alive from the dead
 - * "It is finished." (Jn 19:30)
 - * Jesus finished God's work

2. Basis of Abraham's Righteousness

- a. "Flesh" refers to human work
- b. Justified means becoming acceptable to God
- c. Abraham believed God
 - God counted his faith for righteousness
- d. Abraham never knew Moses Law
 - he died hundreds of years before Moses born

3. Scriptural Basis

- a. Testimony of scripture
 - what does scripture "say"?
(Gen 15:6) - believed God
- b. Abraham believed God
 - before any children
 - before inheriting any land
 - Gal 3:17 - covenant by promise

- 3 c. Testimony of Abraham's response
- Gal 2:16 justified by faith of Jesus
- d. Testimony of God's faithfulness
- counted (imputed) for righteousness
4. Belief of the Righteous
- a. Reward reckoned (earned) of debt
- earned wages are a debt until paid (accounting)
- wages of sin is death (Rom 6:23)
- b. Reward reckoned (counted) of faith
- for person who does not try to earn righteousness
* believe on God's work, his faith counted for righteousness
5. Blessing of Forgiveness
- a. Blessing of imparted (given) righteousness
- God's gift not earned (apart from works)
* whose sins are covered
- b. Blessing of full forgiveness
- person whose lawless deeds (behavior) are forgiven (Ps 32:1)
- c. Imputed gift of money deposited into bank account
- God covers up account showing sin on His bank books
* lawless deeds forgiven
x bad debts written off the books
* sins are covered
- *God's grace
* God's makes deposit of righteousness in His books
