 - why didn't his father tell him

- 4- His father came outside to him
 - a- ~~His~~ his father begged him to come inside to celebrate
 - b. Older son complained to his father
 - Where is my celebration feast?
 - But look at him (younger brother)?
 - * your son!
 - * wasted your livelihood!
 - * look at him!
 - c. Older son highlighted his devotion to his father
 - "I have served you these many years"
 - "I have not broken your commands"
 - d. Touch of bitterness with ~~his~~ anger his anger

- a. Loving presence
 - "You are always with me."
- b. Loving reward
 - "All that I have is yours."
- c. But see the joy of return
 - "Your brother was dead"
 - * "He is now alive"
 - "He was lost"
 - * "and he is now found"
 - "It is fitting that we should rejoice"
