3. THE Design **OF SCRIPTURE** (v. 30-31)

A. Bountiful evidence

"Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know." (Acts 2:22) Peter preaching on Pentecost

Paul speaks "For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: Agrippa II for I am persuaded that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was not done in a corner." (Acts 26:26)

B. Purpose of Revelation (vs 31) these things written - Emperor Domitian started custom of calling Caesar "Dominus et Deus" * saying means "my lord & my God" - But Jesus came ... are written that you ... John, "But these are written that you, may believe that Jesus is the Christ..."
