## 1. Introduction

a. All Christians baptized into Christ's death

- symbolism or picture of old sinful human nature needs to "die"

b. Jesus' resurrection is the picture of new life

## 2. Planting of New Life (vs 5)

a. Planted in spiritual death

- sanctification = continual growth in spiritual maturity

- putting to death of human old man

- Gal 5:19-21 works of the flesh

b. Grafted into body of Christ

c. Risen in new life

- united with Christ in newness of life

- 1 Cor 15:

- we shall also live with Christ

- Christ dies no more

\* we also shall rise from the dead & die no more

## 3. Purpose of New Life (vs 6-9)

a. First ~~the~~ old man crucified

- body of sin done away

- no longer slaves of sin

- dead old man freed from sin

- death no longer rules over old man

- 3b. Live with Christ  
- now that Christ lives, He lives to God  
- count yourself alive to God

c. Christ raised alive out of the grave

4. Founded on God (vs 10)

a. God is the God of the living

- Mk 12:26-27

\* even when Abraham, Isaac, & Jacob died, God sees them as alive

\* God spoke to Moses at the burning bush

\* God is not the God of the dead

b. Jesus made sin for us

- 2 Cor 5:21 For He (God) has made Him (Jesus) to be sin for us

\* Jesus knew no sin

\* that we could be made the righteousness of God

c. Jesus died to sin once for all

- Heb 10:10 the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all

- Heb 7:27 for this He (Jesus) did once when He offered up Himself

- Heb 9:12 by His (Christ) own blood He entered in once into the holy place

- Heb 9:28 Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many

- Heb 10:12 one sacrifice by Christ

- Heb 10:14 one offering Christ did
