1. Introduction

- a. King Ahaz of Judah did evil in God's eyes (2Chron 28:1-2)
- b. He copied religious practices of kings of Israel worshiping Baal
 - King Ahaz sacrificed his sons to the false gods
- c. Prophet Isaiah spoke God's judgment against King Ahaz
- d. But King Hezekiah (son of Ahaz) did what was right (2Chron 29:1)

2. Repair (Step 1) - the temple

- a. King Hezekiah heard Isaiah's prophecies
- b. Rightful Master
 - follow God's commands
- c. Revealed Mission
 - Hezekiah doors to God's temple opened & temple repaired (29:3)
 - He took this action in the 1st month in the 1st year of reign

3. Recognize (Step 2) - our sins

- a. Intolerable Perversion (29:6-7)
 - nation had forsaken God
- b. Inward Purging (29:16)
 - priests cleanse Jewish temple
 - clean up your heart first

4. Returns (Step 3) - to God
 - a. Hunger for worship (29:28-29)
 - desire to worship & praise God)
 - b. Humility in Worship
 - Ps 89, 95:6 kneel before the Lord our Maker
5. Remember (Step 4)
 - a. Celebration of Deliverance
 - do not forget the cross
 - do not forget your salvation
 - b. Caution of Duty (30:25-26)
 - rejoice, great joy in worship
6. Realize (step 5)
 - a. Godless response
 - of 12 disciples, Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus
 - messengers mocked in Ephraim & Manasseh (30:10)
 - b. Greater Result (30:26-27)
 - best results
 - Judah & Israel bringing tithes (31:5-6)
 - Hezekiah pleased God (31:20-21)
