- The disciples marvel at the Temple: ⁵And as some¹ spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly <fancy> stones and gifts, he <Jesus> said,
 - The rich gave gifts to be noticed, and the gifts were displayed in prominent places throughout the Temple. Jesus warned His disciples against self-promotion (20:45-47) and said that such people had already received their reward (Matthew 6: 2-16). Jesus' prophecy regarding the Temple: ⁶As for these things which ye behold, the days will come,

Temple 2 in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. The Temple was the center of Jewish life and their unique place of worship. The disciples temple destroyed history temple

- had heard Jesus predict many things (His own death; Lazarus' resurrection (John 11: 4-14); Jairus' daughter (Luke 8:49-55) but the destruction of the Temple was a shock to them.
- The disciples question Jesus about His prediction: ⁷And they asked him, saying, Master, but when see Acts 111. shall these things be? and what sign will there be when these things shall come to pass?
 - A. Jesus does not answer the question directly, but He does give His disciples and all of us who follow Him a benchmark to strengthen our faith. This was Jesus' second prediction of such an event, see 19: 41-44 Jesus cried over the city
 - B. Jesus expands of the question asked of Him, and tells them of His future coming as the King they were expecting
 - C. Takeaway: Why did Jesus wait until His last week of life to discuss these end-times events? - In 13:7 You don't know now, but you shall
