"Stones Thrown Down"

After Jesus tells His disciples about the destruction of the Jewish Temple, He turns His attention to the end times. His concern for His people (believing Jews and Gentiles) in verses 8 - 19 is threefold:

- I. Religious Delusion: ⁸And he < Jesus> said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ < I am God's chosen leader>; and the time draweth near < and this will happen soon>: go ye not therefore after them.
- II. Distress of Nations: ⁹But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the end is not by and by. ¹⁰Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: ¹¹And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven.
 - A. Wars: "...Nation shall rise against nation..." meaning real wars (Ukraine and Russia) and threatened wars (China and Taiwan). Israel is involved in a war with well-armed militia groups (Hamas and Hezbollah) that are not controlled by their host nations.
 - B. Commotions: "...and kingdom (shall rise against) against kingdom..." This encompasses everything from civil wars to riots, including insurrections, coups, assassinations, and rebellions.
 - C. Earthquakes
 - D. Famines: Not enough food to feed people. This could be lack of food or distribution problems.

 Many African nations are known to withhold food from populations they want to exterminate.
 - E. Pestilences: Sicknesses and bug infestations (COVID) Epidemics, pandemics
 - F. Fearful Sights (Reserved until the Tribulation period)
 - G. Great Signs from Heaven (Reserved until the Tribulation period)

III. Religious Persecution

- A. Official (government) Religious Persecution: ¹²But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you *<arrest>*, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. ¹³And it shall turn to you *<shall be your turn>* for a testimony. ¹⁴Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate *<decide*, *rehearse>* before what ye shall answer: ¹⁵For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries *<police*, *prosecutors*, *judges>* shall not be able to gainsay *<contradict*, *respond to>* nor resist.
- B. Personal Religious Persecution: ¹⁶And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks *<relatives>*, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. ¹⁷And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake ¹⁸But there shall not an hair of your head perish. ¹⁹In your patience *<endurance*, *courage>* possess ye your souls.
- IV. How does Jesus want us to respond?: ²⁸And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh.
