# 2. THE P-0Ce55 (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

# A. Understand the battle

"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh:

4 (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) 5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;" (2 Corinthians 10:3-5)

- When Jesus lived on earth under Roman Empire under reign of Tiberius Caesar, He did not lead armies to set up an earthly kingdom Jesus' temptation in the wilderness by Satam was the first spiritual warfare in his earthly life

#### IT IS NOT PHYSICAL WARFARE

#### IT IS SPIRITUAL WARFARE

"Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. 11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." (Ephesians 6:10–12)

#### B. Utilize Our weapon (v. 4b-5)

Bible compared to sword "And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:" (Ephesians 6:17)

#### A MIGHTY WEAPON

"For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart." (Hebrews 4:12)

**Quote:** "As long as the devil has strongholds of wrong and sinful thought, we cannot be led by the Holy Spirit."

#### 4 STEPS TO A CHRISTIAN MINDSET

FOUR

1. Surrender Your Mind to God

For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not." (Romans 7:18)

"I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin." (Romans 7:25)

2. Substitute Wrong Thoughts with Scripture Thoughts

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things." (Philippians 4:8)

4. Saturate Your Mind with Right Thinking

# 3. THE <u>Product</u> (Romans 12:2)

### A. A renewed Mind (v. 1-2)
