A. Doing What Is <u>right (correct)</u> for Someone, with Someone, and to Someone

command-

"For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. 10 Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the law. "(Romans 13:9-10)

B. Giving Up Your Rights and possessions for Others

"Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God; 4 He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself." (John 13:3-4)

- Jesus led by Holy Spirit to love His disciples to the end of His life

(Mark 9:30, 34-35)

A. With a passion to Be Used by God - work God

(John 13:14-16)

A. He Causes Us to remember What Christ Did for You

B. He Makes Us realize Our Responsibility and Opportunity to Love
